## Let's wrap up 2024!

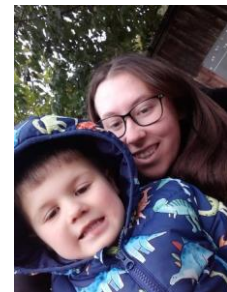

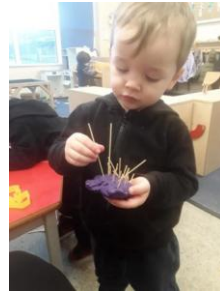

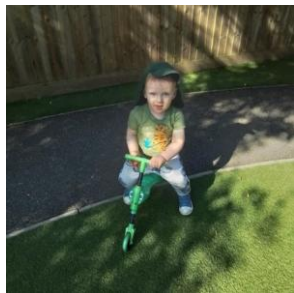

## **Reminders**

### **Information sharing**

We would like to remind everyone of the importance of information sharing. It is so important we know about any changes to the children's home lives, sleep patterns, eating patterns, allergies or medical needs so we can best support them while they are at nursery.

If they haven't had a good night's sleep, tell us. If they have started having medical investigations, tell us. Started long term meds (i.e. inhalers) tell us. Family members visiting, tell us and so on ....

All these things can affect a child's day with us so it's so important we know so we can continue to offer high levels of care and support. Everything is communicated confidentially and, on a need-to-know basis. Our doors and phone lines are always open so don't hesitate to let us know, even the smallest thing.

### **End of the session**

As you are all aware our opening hours are 7:45am-6.00pm. The morning session finishes at 12:45pm and the afternoon session finishes at 6pm. If you would like a detailed handover, we ask that you arrive no later than 5:50pm to enable staff to do this for you. Any collections after your child's session ends will occur a fee. If you are running late, please give us a call to let us know who will be collecting your child.

### **Mobile Phones**

The nursery operates a strict NO mobile phone policy to safeguard the children in our care.



Please refrain from using your mobile phones whilst on the nursery premises, this includes making or receiving phone calls, reading or sending messages, video calls and taking photos when on the premises (both inside and outside).



### Medication:

We understand that all children will become unwell at some point, and this can cause a strain on everyone within the household. For us to stop the spread of illness we ask that if your child needs Calpol or if they have had any prior to starting their nursery day please keep them at home.

If your child is prescribed eye drops, antibiotics, steroids or any other medicated cream's etc. they will need to remain off for 24 hours. Once 24 hours have passed, they are able to return to the setting and staff will administer any medication needed during their session.

All medication must be clearly labelled with your child's name and the required dosage. If you are unsure, please speak to the members of the team.

### Car park

We just want to ask that people take a slower approach when entering the car park. Please remember that at any time, parents could be dropping off or collecting their child, meaning there are children around.

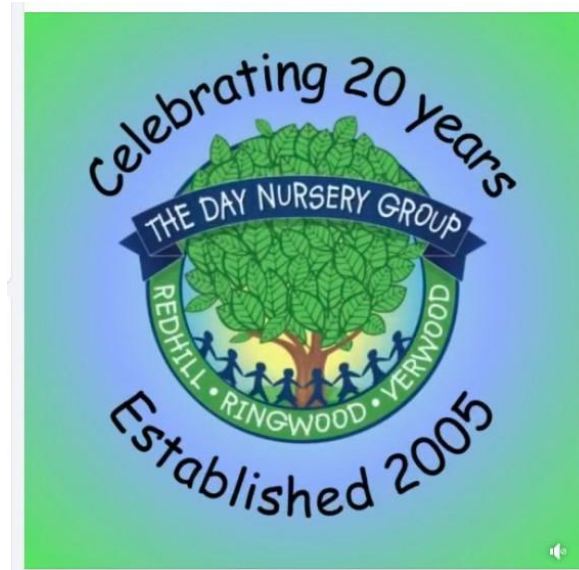


Could people also remember to park respectfully to allow as many vehicles as possible to park and to ensure children are transported safely in and out of the setting by not blocking the gate.
